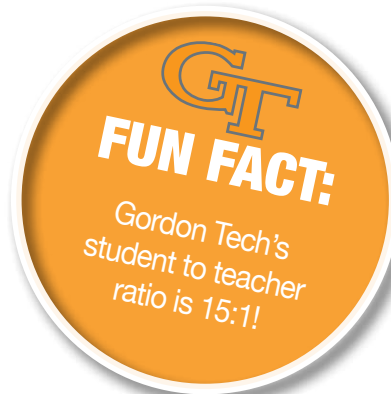

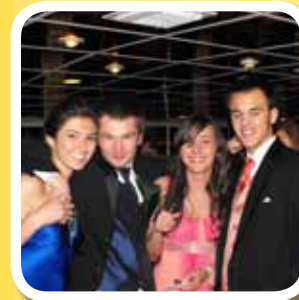
# Excellence in the Arts

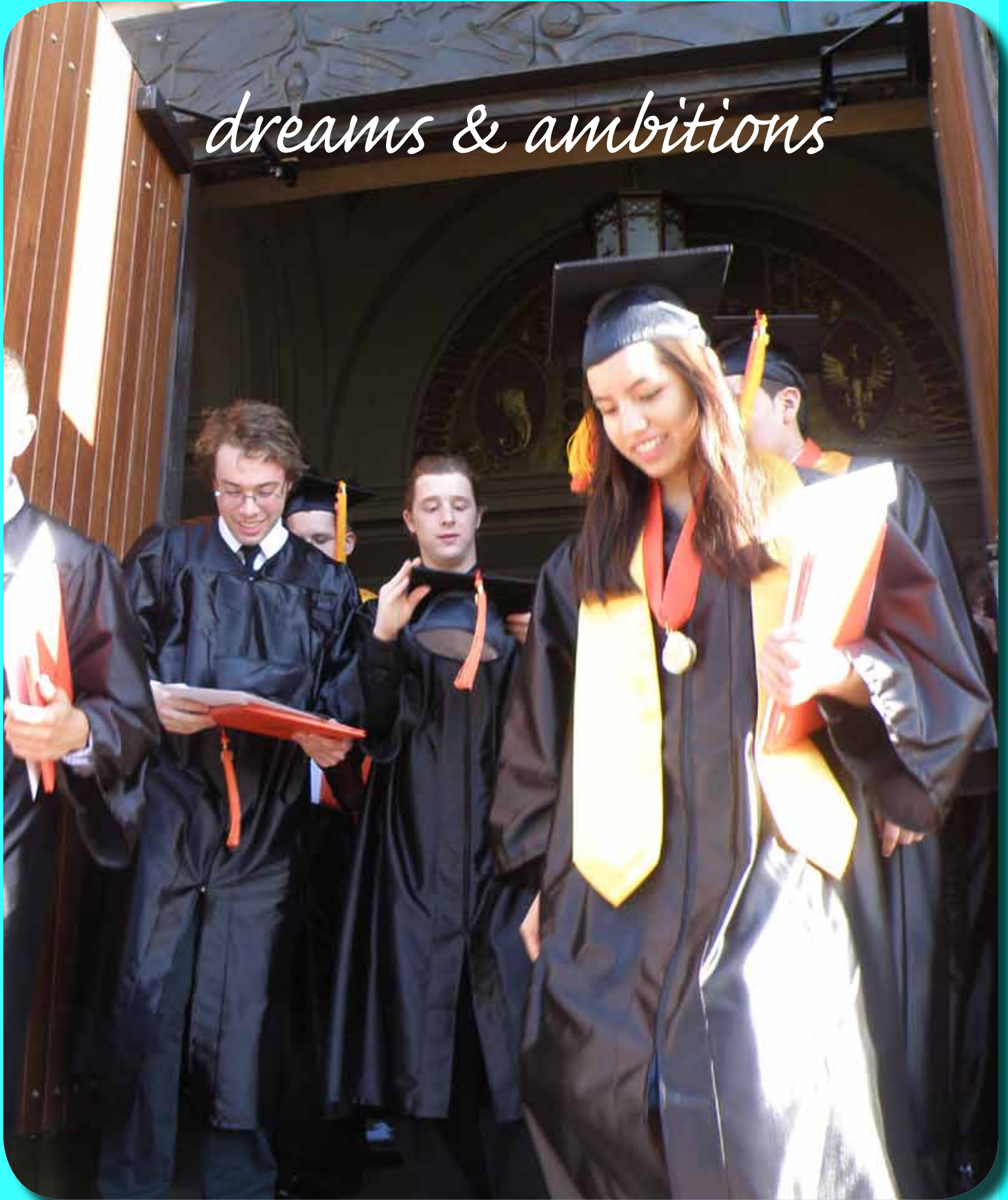
